In addition, a lot of training will occur “on-the-job” and I must be willing and able to take instructions and work hard to be better and better each shift. I also understand that Zoo Crew is an educational volunteer experience and a fee of \$65 +tax (\$70.20) is required. (The money will be used for uniform shirts, orientation materials and processing fees. Do not send money now, you will be contacted by a Zoo employee for a group interview). I understand that after all interviews have been completed only **40** Zoo Crew members will be accepted into the program. I understand that I will be helping with education classes, Roots & Shoots programs, outreach, special events, zookeeping, cleaning, staffing the Zoo Crew Corner in the KidZoo, and other duties as assigned.
