Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department Code of Conduct

The Watertown Parks, Recreation and Forestry Department strives to create an atmosphere of respect and courtesy at all of its facilities. Appropriate social behavior and treatment is expected of all department employees, patrons, and participants. Physical, mental, verbal or emotional abuse will not be allowed by anyone at any time at Department facilities.

This Code of Conduct outlines acceptable/unacceptable behavior. Department employees and Board members are authorized to enforce this Code of Conduct.

Any person engaging in inappropriate conduct may be subject to immediate removal for a period of time deemed appropriate, which may include a permanent ban from Department programs and facilities.

The following activities are prohibited at Watertown Parks, Recreation and Forestry facilities and parks:

- A. Harassment or intimidation using words, gestures, body language or menacing behavior, including activities conducted through social media. (Follow the good letter rules: Keep it clean. Keep it short. Don't Threaten or Abuse. Be Truthful. Be Respectful. Be Proactive. Share your thoughts with us.)
- B. Physical contact with another individual or staff member in an angry, violent or threatening manner;
- C. Any demonstration of sexual activity or sexual suggestiveness;
- D. Carry or concealing weapons or devices that may be used as a weapon;
- E. Use or possession of illegal drugs or alcohol on Park, Recreation and Forestry property where such use or possession is not allowed;
- F. Abuse of Department equipment, supplies and property;
- G. Theft;
- H. Loitering;
- I. The use of tobacco products on City-owned playgrounds and facilities at any time youth activities are occurring;
- J. Continuous poor sportsmanship or overaggressive competitiveness from players or spectators;
- K. Any other behavior deemed unacceptable by those in charge of the facility or activity.

Persons committing any conduct violation may receive a verbal warning, written warning, or may be immediately removed from the facility. In addition to these examples of possible discipline,

individuals may be forbidden to enter upon Department facilities for a period of time, may have any membership suspended for a period of time or may have any membership or prepaid pass revoked with or without refund.

Thank you for your cooperation and for ensuring all Watertown Parks, Recreation and Forestry Department parks and facilities remain a safe and enjoyable place to recreate.

Job Opportunities

The Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department is always looking for qualified individuals to share their special talents (hobbies, skills, etc.). Referees are in constant demand for basketball and volleyball. If you have skills that you would like to share, contact the Department at 605-882-6260.

Refund Policy

It is the policy of the Watertown Park and Recreation Department to refund 100 percent of program fees up to two weeks prior to the start of an activity. Refund requests made after that two week period are refundable at 50 percent of program cost. After program starts, no refunds will be given except for injury or illness. The Director of this department has the right to alter policy based on circumstance.

Persons with Disabilities

The City of Watertown does not discriminate on the basis of disability in the admission or access to, or treatment, or employment in, its programs or activities. The Watertown Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department will attempt to make alternative accommodations to persons with disabilities to allow access to programs and facilities. Call 605-882-6260 24 hours in advance of need or for more information.

Insurance

The Watertown Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department does not carry medical or accident insurance for the participants of our programs. The cost of doing so would be so high that fees charged for programs would become prohibitive. We suggest that you review your family's personal health insurance plan to be sure that it provides you with sufficient coverage.

The Active Heating Sports Zone at the Prairie Lakes Wellness Center-Park and Rec. Courts, City Auditorium, Fieldhouse, Ice Arena, meeting rooms and other Parks, Recreation & Forestry facilities are available for rent.

Picnic Shelter Reservations

The Watertown Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department will take reservations for those who would like to be guaranteed the shelter. Available locations are Bramble, McKinley and City Park. The cost is \$30.00 per time block (11:00am - 5:00pm or 5:00 - 10:00pm). Register at the Parks, Recreation & Forestry Office, 1900 W. Kemp. Advance payment is required to guarantee the shelter.

Fishing Areas

The Park & Recreation Department, in cooperation with the Game, Fish & Parks Department, has stocked fishing areas. The four dedicated areas are:

KIDDIE POND

Located within the Disc Golf Course, just off 10th Avenue NW. This area also has a fishing pier available.

LIONS PARK

Along 3rd Avenue NW, located north and east of the Big Sioux River. Fishing pier available.

JACKSON PARK PIER

Located on South Lake Drive on Lake Kampeska.

MCLAUGHLIN NATURE AREA

4th Avenue SW & SD Hwy 20. Fishing pier available.

Fieldhouse

The Fieldhouse, located at 1900 W. Kemp Avenue, is home to the Parks, Recreation and Forestry's main office. The administrative staff housed in the Fieldhouse consists of the Director, Office Manager, Secretary and all Recreation Staff.

In addition to the main office, the Fieldhouse boasts 7,000 square feet of artificial turf with drop down batting cages, elevated pitching mounds, hitting stations and an open field for practices and various other indoor sporting purposes. It also houses indoor soccer programs in addition to the WYSA's office.

The Fieldhouse also includes a large conference room and training room available to rent to the community.

Forestry Division

The Forestry Division is responsible for approximately 25,000 public trees located along the boulevards, parks and other property owned by the city. The major role of the division is to eliminate dangerous conditions and control the spread of disease. If you have a dangerous or hazardous condition, you can report it on the online tree removal form on the city website at www.watertownparkandrec.com. Go to Forestry and click on the online form, or you can call us at 605-882-6260.

Homeowners are required by city ordinance to contact the City Forestry Division if they plan to remove or plant boulevard trees. If approved, removal will be performed by city employees. Planting will be approved by city forestry staff as to proper distance and variety. Trees cannot be planted on boulevards six feet wide or less.

The Forestry Department sells and plants boulevard trees, limited number available each season. This service is provided for \$50.00/tree. To order trees, you can easily fill out the tree planting form on the city website at www.watertownparkandrec.com or call us at 605-882-6260 to be put on the tree list.

Sidewalk Overhead Limbs – As per Ordinance 11.0713 & 11.0715, it is the responsibility of the owner or occupant of any lot or lots in this city to keep all overhanging limbs of trees trimmed up seven feet above sidewalk level.

Watertown Trolley

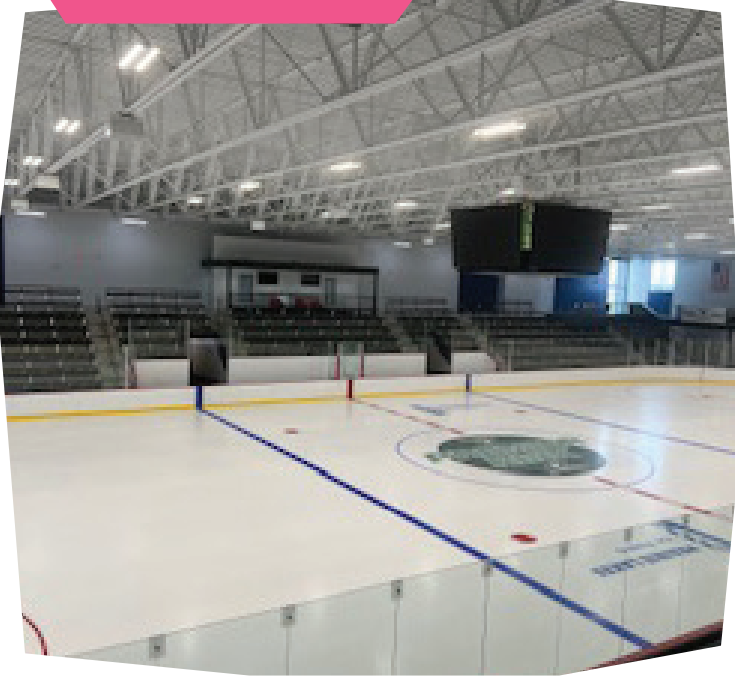
This range is open to the public and free to use. It consists of a number of bays ranging from 25-300 yards with a restroom facility on site and is ADA accessible.

Prairie Lakes Ice Arena

The Prairie Lakes Ice Arena is a 91,000 square foot premier facility for hockey, figure skating and curling located at 3015 1st Avenue NE, Watertown, SD 57201.

The Prairie Lakes Ice Arena opened in early 2024. This state-of-the-art complex has two full standard size rinks to host games and other ice events. It also has two community rooms available to rent for meetings or birthday parties.

Premier Softball Complex

Premier Softball Complex is a state-of-the-art five field complex with concessions, restrooms, and picnic shelters and hosts Lake City Slow Pitch Softball along with weekend tournaments. Premier Softball Complex is located at 1643 17th Street SE, Watertown, SD 57201.

Koch Complex

Koch Complex is a seven field lighted complex which hosts league play for Junior Olympic Slow Pitch Softball and Junior Olympic Fast Pitch Programs along with weekend tournaments. Koch Complex is located on 112 21st St SW.

Foundation Fields

Foundation Fields is a four field complex which hosts league play for Junior League and VFW Baseball which is under the direction of the Watertown Baseball Association. Watertown Park & Rec Bantams games are also played at this site. Foundation Fields are located at 1800 3rd Avenue NW.

City Auditorium

Located at 125 S. Broadway, the "Aud" is utilized year round for sport league play, art and pottery programs and a variety of other programming opportunities.

Anza Soccer Complex

Anza Soccer Complex is an 18 acre facility with 2 full size lighted fields that host league play for the Watertown Soccer Association. Anza Soccer Complex is located at 1620 17 Street SE.

Stokes-Thomas Lake City Park & Campground

Stokes-Thomas Lake City Park & Campground is an excellent recreational facility with modern comfort stations. The park is supervised by a full-time park manager, a camp host, and seasonal staff. The facility has 2 playground areas, a large picnic area with 2 picnic shelters, bike/jogging trail, non-supervised swimming and large beach area. The campground has a tornado shelter, courtesy dock and the park has boat launching facilities and an extremely large parking area.

Stokes-Thomas Lake City Park and Campground has an online reservation system for all camping pads. Four cabins have been added to our campground for your enjoyment. All reservations may be booked starting March 1 for the entire camping season (May 1 - September 30) with a maximum of 14 consecutive days. All of us at Stokes-Thomas Lake City Park are proud of our campground and would be happy to have you as our guest. Our hope is that you have an enjoyable camping experience. Mount Hope Cemetery

Mount Hope Cemetery, located at 11th St. East and 14th Avenue North, is under the direction of Parks & Recreation. Foley Shelter

Foley Shelter is a facility located at 605 3rd Avenue NW which provides community members the access to rent a shelter that features an enclosed area with tables and chairs. This shelter will seat 70 people comfortably. Bathroom access is conveniently located inside and outside of the shelter.

Fee: \$100.00 per day with a \$50.00 damage security deposit

- Weather pending, the last day the shelter will be rented out will be October 15 and re-open May 1.
- Reservations can only be made for the fiscal year in which you are calling.

Skate Park

The Skate Park is located at 314 21st St. SW (West of Koch Complex) and is free to use. Helmet and all other protective gear including knee, elbow and wrist pads are highly recommended. Skate at your own risk. The Skate Park is open dawn till dusk. Use of the facility is prohibited when wet, during park maintenance or scheduled activities.

Nelson Park Pickleball Courts

Three pickleball courts are available to play at Nelson Park located at S. Broadway & 5th Avenue SW. The courts are available on a first-come, first-serve basis and we ask that everyone be courteous to each other and try to keep the courts clean.

Disc Golf Courses

SLUMBERLAND DISC GOLF COURSE

The Watertown Slumberland Disc Golf Course is open year round and is free to play. This 18-hole course, located off 10th Avenue North, next to the Kiddie Pond consists of an intermediate nine holes and an advanced nine holes. Leagues and tournaments are also offered.

JACKSON CROSSING DISC GOLF COURSE

Jackson Crossing Disc Golf Course has 9 challenging holes located alongside beautiful Lake Kampeska at Jackson Park (250 South Lake Drive right across from Cattail Crossing Golf Course). Jackson Crossing is one of the top courses in the area and we invite everyone out to play a round and try to tackle the signature Hole #9, the toughest hole in northeast South Dakota.

Dog Park

Located at 10th Avenue N and 7th St. E. (next to the community gardens) is open and free to enjoy from dawn to dusk 7 days a week. The completely fenced off area is broken into two sections: one for smaller dogs and the second for larger sporting dogs. The entrance is off the parking lot on the north side of the community gardens. Not only will your dog enjoy the freedom of running around and playing but you will be able to challenge your dog with the dog agility equipment that is at the park.

CONTROL MOSQUITO

The Park and Recreation Department, along with the City of Watertown, SDSU Cooperative Extension and the South Dakota Department of Health, want to help you reduce the mosquito numbers in your neighborhood. When using DEET here are some helpful reminders.

- Do not allow children to apply.
- Apply to exposed skin and clothing.
- Do not spray near face or inhale mist.

PROTECT YOURSELF!

Consider these areas of breeding areas for mosquitoes and do your best to keep water fresh. If not using these areas, drain the water: pet dishes, buckets, bird baths, wading pools, wagons, wheelbarrows, tires, pots/planters, plugged rain gutters, leaky faucets, pickup boxes and culverts.

We recognize Medica and Humana Insurance Plans for the Silver Sneakers Program. Please bring in your card to verify eligibility. If you qualify for a free membership through one of these plans, you receive a Basic Fitness Membership and may attend Silver Sneakers classes at no cost. All other classes are an additional fee.

We also participate in programs with other insurance programs that may reimburse you based on gym attendance. Please stop in or contact your insurance provider to see if you are eligible for a "fitness benefit".

MEMBERSHIP REFUND POLICY

Memberships are not refundable or transferable. Annual memberships run one calendar year from purchase date. Monthly memberships are regarded as continuous until 30 day written notice of cancellation is given.





LOCKER RENTAL

Lockers are available on a daily basis at no charge. You must remove your personal lock and your belongings when you leave the facility. You may rent a locker annually for \$60, which includes tax. This fee will be billed each January via invoice or ACH debit, and pro-rated based on when you set up locker rental during the year.

FACILITY RULES

1. All patrons must enter through the main front entrance and check in.
2. Non-members must purchase a day pass to use any part of the facility.
3. Children in Kindergarten and under must be supervised at all times.
4. Children in grades 1st - 6th must have a parent or responsible guardian (age 16 or older) in the building at all times.
5. Members must be in the 7th grade or older to lift weights, use cardio or weight machines, or be on the track without adult supervision.
6. Clean athletic shoes and proper workout attire must be worn.
7. Always wipe down and replace equipment after use.
8. Be courteous to others and refrain from using profanity.
9. One shower towel and one sweat towel will be provided per member at check-in. Please place used towels in the laundry receptacles as you exit.
10. Please adhere to all other rules as posted throughout the facility.



BASIC FITNESS MEMBERSHIP

OUTDOOR SWIMMING LESSONS

2024 AMERICAN RED CROSS SWIMMING LEVEL DESCRIPTIONS

The American Red Cross Swimming Program teaches people of all ages and varying abilities to swim and be safe in, on and around water. ARC classes take an inclusive approach that emphasizes skill development in conjunction with water safety and drowning prevention education.

Parent & Child Aquatics (6months-3 years): Familiarize children with the water and teach swimming readiness skills, provides safety information for parents, and teach parents techniques they can use to help orient their children to the water.

Prep 1: For children 3-4 years old who have little or no previous water experience. The purpose is to facilitate developmentally appropriate learning of fundamental water safety and aquatic skills.

Level 1 – Introduction to Water Skills: Introduces basic aquatic skills, which participants continue to build on as they progress through Learn-to-Swim. Participants start developing positive attitudes, effective swimming habits and safe practices in and around the water.

Level 2 – Fundamental Aquatic Skills: Gives students success with fundamental skills. This level marks the beginning of true locomotion skills. Participants learn to glide and float without support and recover to a vertical position. Participants further develop simultaneous and alternating arm and leg actions on the front and back, laying the foundation for future strokes.

Level 3 – Stroke Development: Expand proficiency of previously learned skills by providing additional guided practice. Participants learn to swim front crawl and elementary backstroke at rudimentary proficiency levels. Introduce the scissors and dolphin kicks and extend the time duration for treading water. Learn to enter the water headfirst from a seated position at poolside.

Level 4 – Stroke Improvement: Participants improve their aquatic skills and increase their endurance by swimming the strokes learned in Level 3 (i.e. front crawl, elementary backstroke) for greater distances and with more advanced proficiency. Participants add arm actions to the previously learned scissors kick and breaststroke kick to perform the rudimentary sidestroke and to learn the breaststroke. Participants also begin to learn the back crawl and butterfly, as well as the basics of performing a simple open turn at a wall.

Level 5 – Stroke Refinement: Participants refine their performance of all six strokes (i.e., front crawl, back crawl, butterfly, breaststroke, elementary backstroke and sidestroke) and increase the distances that they swim. Participants also learn to perform flip turns on the front and back.

Level 6 – Personal Water Safety: Refines the strokes so participants swim them with greater efficiency and effectiveness over longer distances.

Outdoor Swimming Lessons

Session 1 & 4 are 45 minute classes for 8 days, Session 2,3 & 5 are 60 minute classes for 5 days.

NOTE: Parent & Child Aquatics, Prep 1, & Level 1 meet for 45 minutes in one-week session, 30 minutes in two-week session.

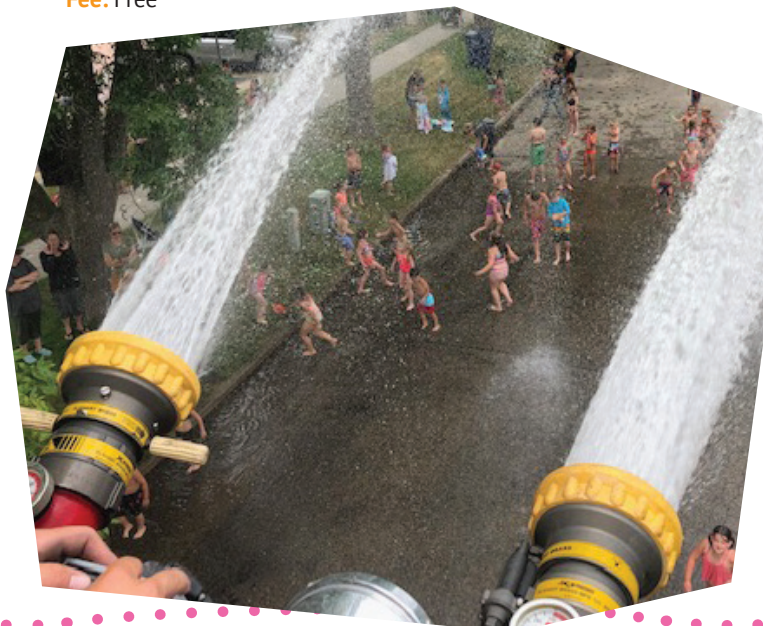

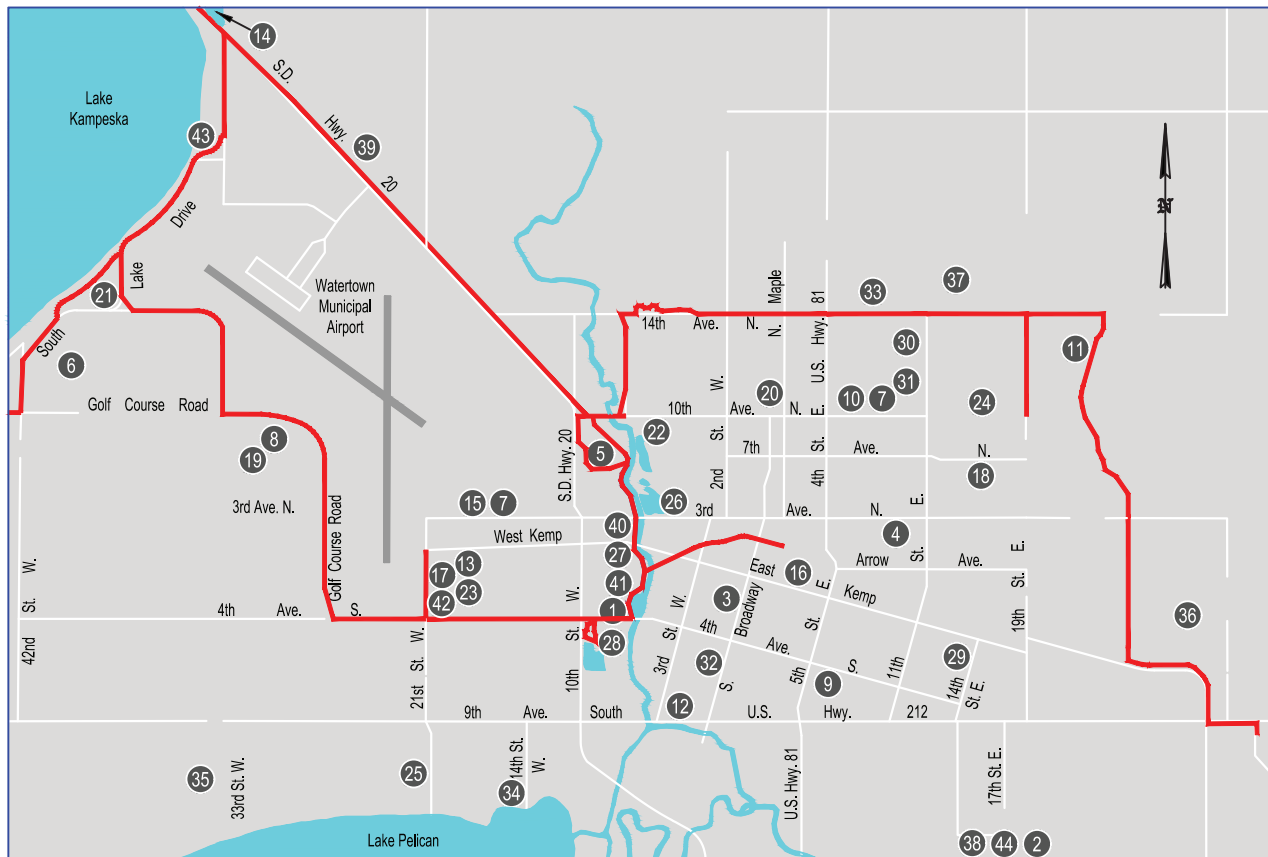
